1- Use of Cookies

A cookie is a small text file that a website stores on your computer or mobile device when you visit that site. Cookies allow the website to remember the pages you visited and your preferences (such as username, language, font size, and other settings) so you don't have to re-enter them each time you visit the site. Cookies cannot be used to identify individuals; they can only identify machines.

2- Types of Cookies

HISTORALIA uses different types of cookies:

- **First-Party Cookies:** These are technical cookies used by the website itself to enhance its performance. For example, we use them to track your data from previous visits.

- Language Cookies: These cookies help us remember your language preference, so we don't need to ask for it each time you visit the site.

- Third-Party Cookies: These cookies are set by parties other than the website, such as marketing or advertising plugins. Examples include cookies from Facebook or Google Analytics. Visitors to the website must give their consent for these cookies. A link to this policy may be found at the top or bottom of the website but does not prevent further access to the website. We use third-party cookies from Facebook, Google Analytics, and Google Retargeting.

How to Learn More and Manage Cookies

You can control and/or delete cookies at any time. More information on cookies is available at aboutcookies.org. You can delete all cookies from your computer and set your browser to block cookies. This may require you to re-enter your preferences each time you visit the website and may affect the functionality of certain parts of the site. You can configure your internet browser to block cookies, alert you when a cookie is set, or delete cookies from your hard drive after your visit.
